QUESTION 3:

Do you have areas where you feel like you are beginning to look like Jesus? What truths do you hold true to? What are some things that you would like to improve?

QUESTION 4:

Why is it so difficult to go down the path of offering forgiveness when someone has hurt you? What are some things you can practice in this area of your life in order to have a special use for the Kingdom rather than only a common use?

CLOSING CHALLENGE:

Take time this week to reread this passage and pay close attention to verse 21 that talks about cleansing yourself so that you may be instruments for special purposes. What is that special purpose God wants you to step into? What is keeping you from your purpose?
