ICE BREAKER:

When I hear the phrase "passing the torch," my mind immediately goes to the Olympics. Discuss your favorite moments during the Olympics.

QUESTION 1:

There have been famous last words recorded all throughout history. David's last words refer to him as an exceptional singer / worship leader. Why do you think he picked this reference over all of his other accolades?

If you had to write your own "famous last words" speech, what message would you send?

QUESTION 2:

The study on The Life of David has taken a deep dive into the good, bad, and ugly parts of David's life. How would you best describe the legacy David left behind?

QUESTION 3:

One of the major themes discussed in this week's teaching is the word "Legacy." You have studied David's legacy in depth. What are some important characteristics that you want connected to your legacy? Why are these important to you?

QUESTION 4:

Another major theme mentioned in the teaching is: "God takes broken things and makes them beautiful." Discuss how you have been encouraged by this truth from past experiences.

CLOSING CHALLENGE:

David's final charge as a father to his son Solomon was to center his life around seeking God and building his house. Consider this same challenge and put into practice some action steps that will accomplish this task.
