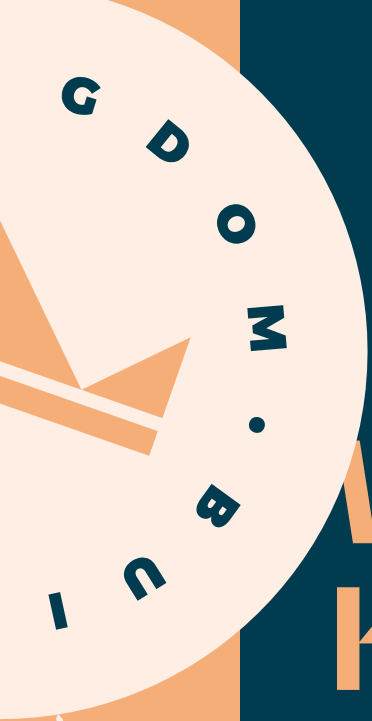

GLOBAL MISSIONS

Kingdom Builders is committed to advancing God's Kingdom in a multitude of ways, including constructing churches, homes, and schools, as well as digging water wells worldwide. Our efforts also involve equipping and training local pastors to ensure long-term spiritual growth and development.

We are beyond blessed to partner with trusted, Kingdom-minded ministries across the globe. Without them, or you, we wouldn't be able to embark on missions like planting a church in Ireland or helping children with disabilities in Kenya.

Together, we are fulfilling the call of Acts 1:8: "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Financial Goal: \$450,000

Meals for Refugees in Uganda

Kingdom Builders partners with the ministry of Pastor Solomon and Good News Church in Uganda to feed the starving people in their local communities and in refugee settlements. The church also ministers to their spiritual needs by sharing the love and hope of Jesus.

Build Churches / India Gospel League

Despite increasing persecution and efforts to hinder the growth of Christian communities in India, many people continue to encounter the Lord and seek fellowship through home churches. This project supports these growing groups by providing multi-purpose church buildings for congregations that have outgrown their home gatherings.

Christ Faith Home for Children in India

Our partner, Christ Faith Home for Children in India, is dedicated to living out the call of James 1:27, which says, “Pure and genuine religion in the sight of God the Father means caring for orphans and widows in their distress.” Through a variety of impactful programs, they provide essential housing, nutrition, medical care, education, and life-skills training to India’s most vulnerable populations, including orphans, widows, and lepers. This organization exemplifies the heart of compassionate ministry, bringing hope and support to those in need.

San Pedro Sula Dream Center

The Dream Center in San Pedro Sula, Honduras, is a vibrant ministry dedicated to supporting at-risk children and youth by providing a daily meal and a safe, nurturing environment where they can build meaningful relationships within a Christian community. In addition to educational assistance and life skills development, the Dream Center offers comprehensive support to vulnerable families and the elderly, addressing their physical, emotional, and spiritual needs.

Honduras Jungle Hospital

Since 2007, the Jungle Hospital has been a beacon of healing and hope for communities across more than 1,000 square miles of jungle in northern Honduras. Led by Dr. Martin and Wendy Williams, the hospital provides vital inpatient and outpatient care as well as medical and dental brigades to surrounding villages. Their initiatives also include essential dietary and hygiene education in local schools, promoting health and well-being throughout the region. Beyond medical care, they build meaningful relationships that allow them to share the greatest message of all—the gift of Christ.

Royal Gathering Education Center in Kenya

In Kenya, a child's opportunity to attend public school depends on whether their family can afford yearly school fees and uniforms—a requirement that leaves many children unable to pursue an education, limiting their chances to escape the cycle of poverty. Founded in 2013 by Pastor Ken Murichio, the Royal Gathering Children's Center works to remove this barrier by providing children with access to schooling along with holistic support for their body, mind, and spirit. Through this initiative, children are empowered with the foundation needed to transform their futures, make a positive impact on their communities, and become influential leaders for their country and beyond.

Water for Nations in Kenya

In Kenya's rural regions, many families rely on water sources shared with animals like cows and donkeys, leading to significant health risks. Mike and Tammy McRae, together with Water for Nations, are dedicated to bringing clean, safe water to these communities and sharing the "water of life" with everyone they meet. By drilling wells, they offer hope and improve the lives of hundreds at a time, providing access to clean water that transforms both health and daily life. With clean water close by, children can attend school instead of spending hours fetching water, and families have more time together. This newfound resource also creates opportunities for sustainable agricultural and business development, setting up these communities for a healthier, more prosperous future.

“Send100” is a bold initiative to send 100 missionaries to the mission field by 2040! Through Send100, CityHope is committed to equipping and supporting individuals and families who feel called to serve globally for at least one year. Sending a missionary includes mentoring, training, partnerships with sending organizations, fundraising, preparation, and ongoing prayer and support. CityHope provides the resources our missionaries need to answer this call and make a lasting impact in communities around the world.

Through Send100, a dedicated team of experienced missionary mentors guide participants through each step of their journey. From discerning the initial call to missions, connecting with a sending organization, and navigating the crucial steps of fundraising, preparation, and packing, our team provides comprehensive support.

Konbit Haiti

Konbit Haiti, meaning “coming together for a common good,” has been working alongside rural Haitian communities and local leaders since 2010. Their mission centers on creating sustainable water and sanitation solutions while promoting holistic family development. Thanks to support from Kingdom Builders, Konbit Haiti continues to provide essential resources to the Haitian people, including school supplies, nutritious meals, summer camps, holiday programs, emergency assistance, health education, and access to clean drinking water.

The Palm / Kenya

The Palm, a ministry of Water for Nations, offers compassion, support, and hope to teenage girls facing crisis pregnancies. Born out of a deep commitment to empowerment and healing, The Palm seeks to help these young women embrace the full potential and purpose that God has for them, even amid difficult circumstances.

Ireland Church Plant Ministry To Israel

Led by dedicated partner missionaries with a deep passion for reaching the local community, efforts are underway to explore Ireland as a potential site for a new church. Recognizing the unique needs of the Irish culture, the goal is to establish a vibrant, welcoming church that will serve as a center for faith, outreach, and connection. This initiative is supported through financial resources, strategic guidance, and ongoing encouragement for the team on the ground.

In response to God's calling, Jewish people are returning to Israel from nations where they've been dispersed for the past 2,000 years, coming home to the Promised Land. This prophetic return, however, brings immense challenges, as many newcomers face a culture with a language they may not know, and a region marked by surrounding nations opposed to their presence. Ministry to Israel has been instrumental in supporting these individuals, offering essential aid as they settle into their homeland. By financially supporting this mission, Gentile believers and the Church can actively participate in fulfilling God's prophetic promise to His chosen people.





Emergé Missions

For more than 35 years, Emergé Missions has worked to help young people in Southeast Asia escape the cycles of generational poverty and exploitation. By empowering local leaders to become champions within their communities, Emergé Missions organizes children into supportive groups, fostering a safe and encouraging environment. Through these groups, they offer spiritual guidance, protection, essential skills, and education, equipping vulnerable youth with the tools they need to overcome the difficult circumstances they face.

This reflects the "Jerusalem" aspect of Acts 1:8—our commitment to serving local communities and ministry partners right here at home.

Financial Goal: \$600,000

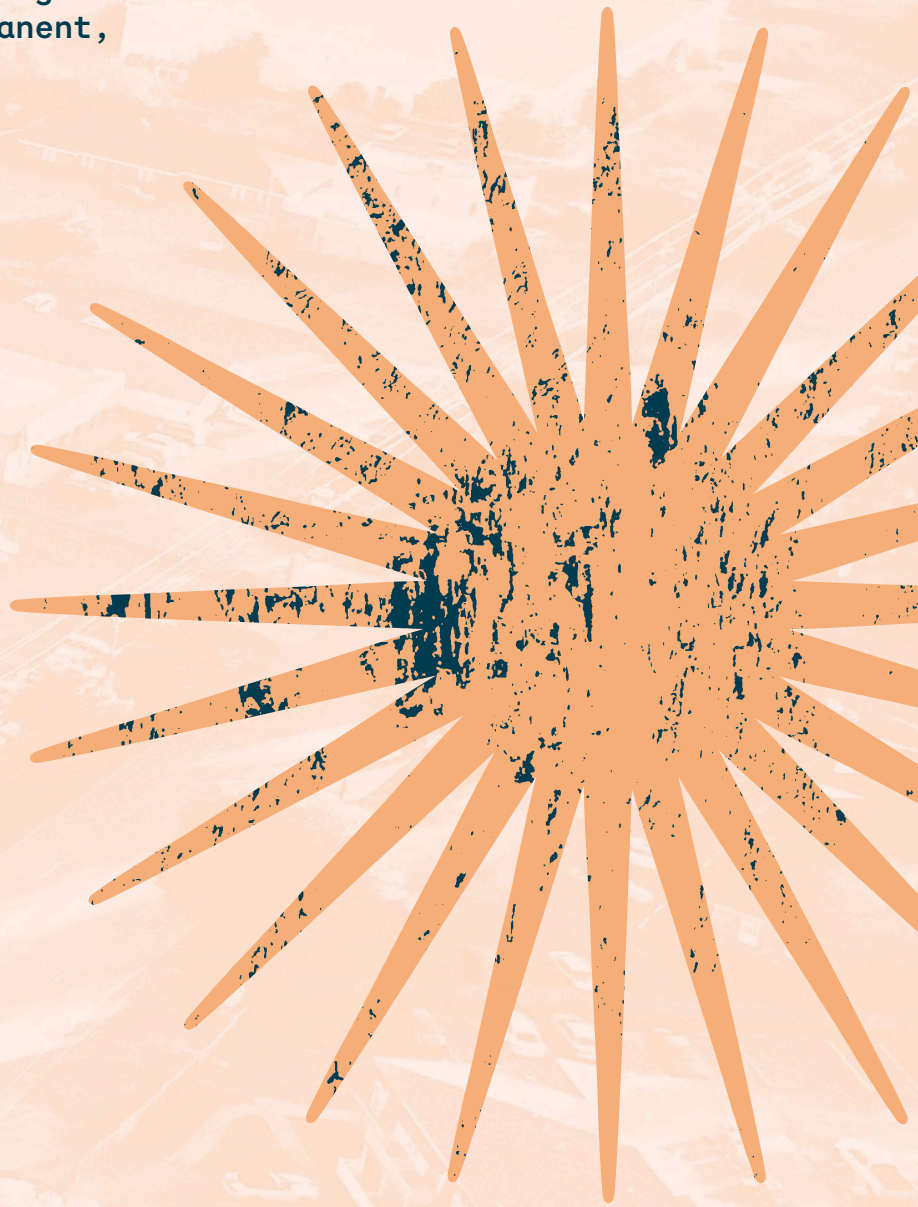




MOBILE CAMPUS PURCHASE

Church Planting

Our church planting efforts are rooted in a vision to bring vibrant, gospel-centered communities to cities and neighborhoods in need of hope and transformation. Beginning with Eden Church in Houston, Texas, launched to reach the diverse and growing population of Houston, Eden focuses on fostering authentic connections, teaching biblical truth, and serving the community with practical outreach. This church plant serves as a model for future efforts, as we seek to establish churches that reflect God's love and meet the unique needs of their surrounding communities. Our goal is to plant churches that will thrive and grow, becoming catalysts for spiritual and social renewal in cities across the nation and beyond.



Merry Christmas Gulf Coast & Correctional Christmas

For over two decades, Merry Christmas Gulf Coast has been our largest and most impactful annual community outreach. This initiative brings the joy and warmth of Christmas to about one thousand children in our community, creating lasting Christmas memories. It also reaches beyond, instilling hope and a sense of belonging by delivering Christmas gifts to 2,500 men in five correctional facilities across Alabama. Through Merry Christmas Gulf Coast, we share the love of Jesus with many that may go without hope in the season.

Rather than merely reacting, the ministry is equipped with cutting-edge tools and thorough training to respond effectively. This support also enables CityHope to assist ministry partners around the globe, providing vital aid during challenging times and making a difference when it matters most.

CityHope Correctional Ministry

CityHope faithfully shares the gospel message each week with inmates across five correctional facilities in our region. Through a team of trained, dedicated volunteers, we come alongside hundreds of men on their journey to follow Jesus. Throughout the year, CityHope offers a streamed weekend experience, facilitates the Dust Discipleship Journey, offers CityHope College PM classes, and provides ongoing support for both inmates and correctional staff. This ministry brings hope, connection, and encouragement, helping to transform lives from the inside out.

Women's Care & Resource Centers

Kingdom Builders partners with two different women's centers across Baldwin and Mobile counties. Through compassionate care, education, and support for clients at any stage of their journey, our partners are trusted resources for women and men with unplanned pregnancies and beyond. Services include pregnancy and STI testing and treatment, counseling, parenting-related classes, post-abortive recovery, miscarriage support, and educational outreach in local schools aimed at informing youth about healthy relationships and decision-making.

LA Dream Center

The Los Angeles Dream Center provides individuals with an opportunity to rebuild and transform their lives through a range of free programs offering tools, education, community, and support. With outreach, transitional housing, fire relief stations, and resource initiatives, lives are changed to the glory of God.

CityHope's local outreach consists of several initiatives, including providing meals for hundreds of local families each summer, conducting a monthly Dream Center Truck Ministry, engaging in homeless outreaches, and participating in other local outreach projects in Mobile and Baldwin County.

Baldwin Family Village is Baldwin County's first transitional program for women and children experiencing homelessness. They have been very successful in transitioning individuals into permanent housing through comprehensive support services, life skills training, and helping residents achieve self-sufficiency.

Light of the Village

In 2001, a drug house was transformed into a place of Christian faith, hope, and love. Light of the Village is a front-line, hands-on ministry that serves inside their Mobile community six days a week offering a variety of programs. This consistent outreach is where genuine relationships are built, and Christ can be shared one person at a time.
